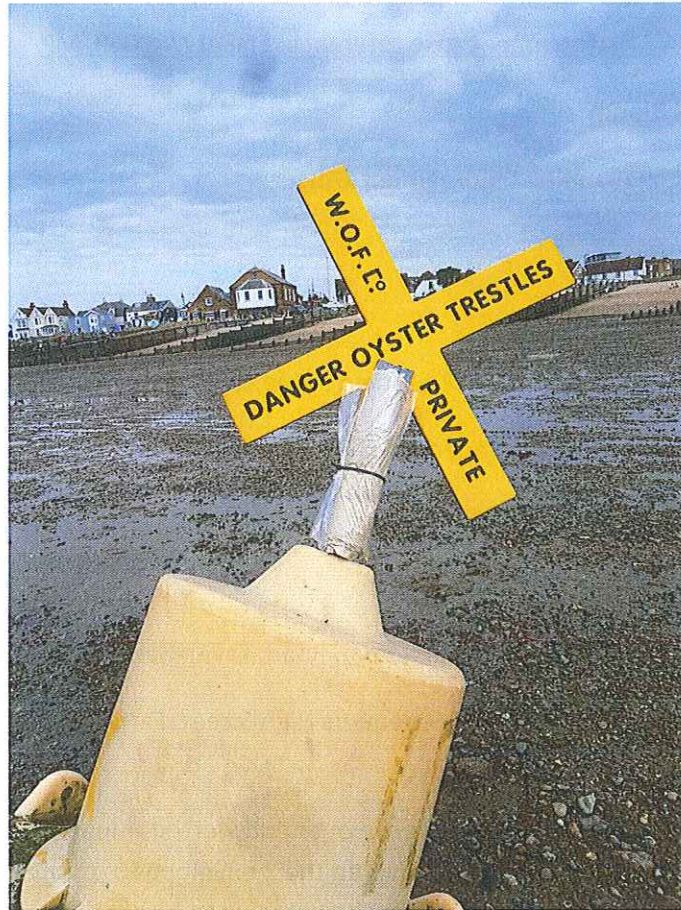
I hereby declare that on the 10th July 2018 at 16.50pm, I served a true copy of the same documents as stated in 1. and 2. above on the land. The envelopes were addressed to the following interested parties:

The documents were each sealed in brown envelopes and were stamped with "This Important Communication Affects Your Property". The brown envelopes containing the enforcement notice and S37 enforcement notice were each placed in a sealed transparent waterproof pouch.

I secured the sealed waterproof envelope to the pole on a yellow marker buoy that was attached by a metal chain to the sea bed. This was secured with a plastic cable tie. The only means to remove it would be to cut the cable tie off.
